

Aliso Niguel High School / CUSD Athletic Eligibility Requirements

The following general guidelines will be used to determine initial academic athletic eligibility. Individual teams / sports can raise the level of academic eligibility. These additional requirements will be outlined in each sport's code of conduct. These team guidelines apply to all potential student-athletes who are either participating in a CIF approved sport or will be trying out for a CIF approved sport. Cheer / Pep / Dance will have additional requirements, and potential students will need to check with each advisor of these programs for specifics.

Provision #1)

All students must be currently enrolled in 25 semester units of work during the season of sport. Each semester class is equivalent to five (5) credits. No probationary period is allowed for this requirement.

Provision #2)

All students must have passed 20 credits of semester work the previous official grading period. Each semester class is equivalent to five (5) credits. No probationary period is allowed for this requirement. Only one Physical Education / Team Sport class may be counted toward the determining of the 20 semester credits each grading period.

Provision #3)

The student's GPA must be above a 2.0 during the previous semester (official grading period). In addition, a physical education class can only be counted once in determining this 2.0 standard.

An academic probation period is allowable for this and will be determined by the Athletic Director. Academic probation is not at the discretion of the student, but an automatic event when a student's GPA falls below the 2.0 standard.

Provision #4)

A student becomes ineligible when he / she has two consecutive semesters below the 2.0 GPA standard. The ineligible period lasts for one official grading period (semester). If a student is able to raise his / her GPA during this time frame, they will be returned to eligible status at the start of the next semester.
